

Charter for People with Disabilities



To improve the comfort of persons with disabilities, reserved spaces are available at both stages of the NJF.

➤ **As these spaces are limited in number, priority access is granted to holders of a PMR/PSH ticket:**

- Wheelchair users
- Individuals with significant difficulty standing

Access may also be extended to other persons with disabilities if space becomes available once the concert has begun.

➤ **Form:**

To allow our teams to best prepare for your arrival and assistance at the festival, **it is strongly recommended to complete the dedicated form** for persons with disabilities (available on the [Accessibility page of the official Nice Jazz Fest website](#), under the « *Before* » section).

➤ **Team members (or civil reserve staff) will be on-site to manage reception and seating according to individual needs : They alone are authorized** to assess access priorities based on availability and adjust capacity according to the number of wheelchairs. For safety or crowd-control reasons, **access may be temporarily or permanently denied.**

➤ **Companions:**

Only one standing companion is permitted to access the reserved spaces.

Depending on attendance, the companion may be asked to yield their space to a priority individual.

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Where are the dedicated spaces located?

Théâtre de Verdure:

A designated area at the top of the stands provides optimal concert viewing conditions. It can accommodate 25 wheelchair users and their companion.

Place Masséna:

Two PSH spaces will be located at the rear of the Masséna stage. Together, they can accommodate 24 wheelchair users and their companion.

The capacity of these spaces ensures the safety of all attendees in case of an incident. It also allows users to move freely during the evening to access other festival areas.

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The team at the »Handi-accueil» Information Point can escort you to one of the reserved spaces. Seating will be arranged based on individual needs (subject to availability).

These measures are implemented for the comfort and safety of all.

It is essential to present yourself to a member of the Handi-accueil team at the Information Point or at the entrance of the dedicated areas with your PMR ticket and your disability card (or supporting document) to gain access. It is strongly recommended to have completed the online form in advance.
